Subject: NPIs for High Disease Prevalence Districts

NCOC session dated 14 September 21reference.

1. NCOC session chaired by Mr Asad Umer (Minister for Planning, Development and Special Initiatives) was held on 14 September 21. A detailed stock of the disease situation in the country, daily hospital admissions and critical care occupancy vis-à-vis requirement of oxygen was carried out. Forum unanimously agreed for enforcement of stringent NPIs in 6 x high disease prevalence districts. Fresh list of high disease prevalence districts is as under:

Federating Units	Districts

- 2. NPIs for high disease prevalence districts and rest of the country are attached at **Annex A**.
- 3. <u>Education Sector</u>. All types of education institutes countrywide will follow staggered opening (50% attendance, 3 x days a week) from 16th September 21 onwards.
- 4. A close monitoring of disease prevalence / critical health care system is being carried out at NCOC on daily basis and necessary decisions will be taken whenever deemed appropriate to control the disease spread.
- 5. **NPIs** for **high disease prevalence districts** will remain enforced from **16** to **22 September 21** and review will be carried out in NCOC on **21 September 21**.
- 6. **NPIs** for **rest of the country** will remain enforced from **16** to **30 September 21** and review will be carried out in NCOC on **28 September 21**.

7. All concerned are requested to **issue notifications** and disseminate to all concerned at

d.	Weddings	Indoor marriages allowed only for vaccinated individuals with maximum limit of 200 x guests. Outdoor marriages allowed with maximum 400 x guests under strict COVID protocols.	Ban on Indoor weddings. Outdoor weddings allowed with maximum 400 x guests under strict COVID protocols.	
e.	Gatherings	Indoor gatherings allowed only for vaccinated individuals with maximum limit of 200 x individuals. Outdoor gatherings allowed with maximum 400 x individuals under strict COVID protocols.	Ban on all types of indoor gatherings including cultural, musical / religious / miscellaneous event. Outdoor gatherings allowed with maximum 400 x individuals under strict COVID protocols.	
f.	Religious	Shrines allowed to reopen at the discretion of Federating Units / local administration.	Shrines will continue to remain closed.	
g.	Office Routine	Normal working hours with 100% attendance.	Normal office working hours for public / private offices with 50% attendance	
h.	Cinemas	Cinemas will continue to remain closed.		
i.	Sports	Continuation of ban on contact sports (Karate, Boxing, Martial Arts, Rugby, Water Polo, Kabaddi & Wrestling).		
j.	Gyms	Continuation of indoor Gyms for vaccinated individuals only.		
k.	Public Transport	Occupancy level of public transport will be 50%. Ban is imposed on all type of snacks serving to the passengers during journey by the transport services.		
I.	Railways	Rail services will continue to operate with 70% occupancy under strict COVID protocols.		
m.	Recreation	Amusement Parks, Water Sports and Swimming Pools to continue activities at 50% of capacity. Public parks will remain open under strict COVID protocols.	Same NPIs as of Low Disease Prevalence Districts.	
n.	Extended Lockdowns	Broader lockdowns with stringent enforcement protocols based on risk assessment will continue. NCOC will regularly share heat maps with federating units for implementation of targeted SLDs / mSLDs.		
0.	Mask Wearing	Compliance to compulsory mask wearing while incorporating innovative measures for enforcement.		
p.	Tourism	Policy of controlled tourism for vaccinated individuals will continue and will be ensured by federating units.		
q.	Domestic Air Travel Meals	Ban on serving of meals / snacks during inflight journey for domestic airlines will continue.		
r.	Inbound Passenger policy	Current inbound passenger policy will continue till further orders.
